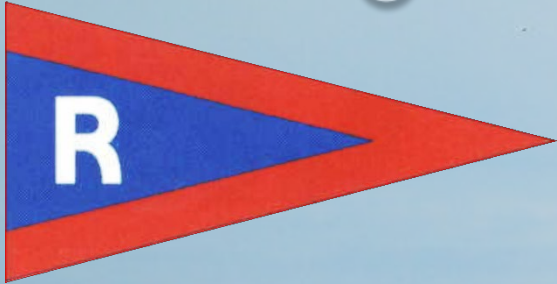

RACE RE-CAP

- VERY LIGHT AIR UPWIND SAILING WAS FOUND AT THE START. BLUE KNIGHT AND UPRISING DID THE BEST JOB NAVIGATING OUT FROM THE DOLDRUMS AROUND ROCHESTER TOWARDS NINE MILE POINT. ONCE THE FLEET ARRIVED TO THIS SPOT AFTER A FEW HOURS OF BATTLING CALM CONDITIONS, THE BREEZE SLOWLY BEGAN TO FILL. THE MAJORITY OF THE 18MILE LEG TO THE BUOY OFF PYC WAS NOW UPWIND, WITH STARBOARD BEING THE “LONG” TACK. A FEW SHORT TACKS WERE NEEDED BY BOATS TO GET AROUND THE KEEP OFF BUOYS AT THE NUCLEAR PLANT. PASSING ALL THE FLEET THAT LEFT FROM PULTNEYVILLE WITH SPINNAKERS WAS A GREAT HIGHLIGHT!
- ON THE RETURN LEG BACK TO ROCHESTER IT WAS A STEADY LIGHT NE WIND AND A BEAUTIFUL DAY. ALL THE BOATS WERE NOW UNDER SPINNAKER. MOST OF THE LEG WAS A BROAD REACH, WITH ONLY A GYBE OR TWO NEEDED AT THE VERY END TO FINISH JUST EAST OF THE PIER IN ROCHESTER. GOOD COMPETITION, LIGHT AIR, TIGHT RACING AND A BEAUTIFUL SUNNY DAY WAS THE MAIN THEME.

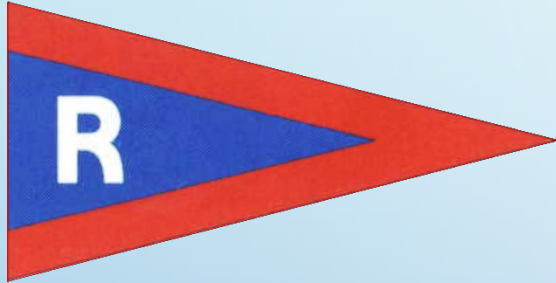

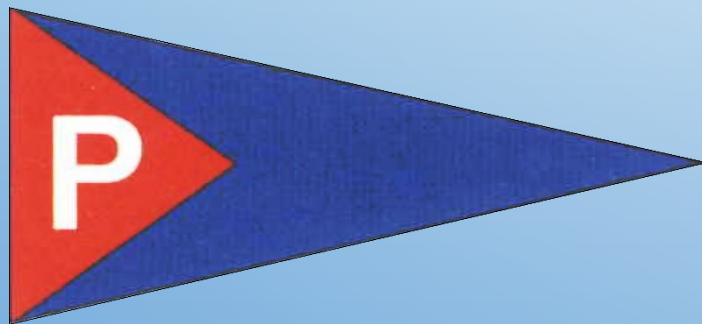

- RACE START AT 10:30AM

- DOWNWIND/SPINNAKER RUN TO THE RIVER
- DURING RETURN TRIP WIND WENT LIGHT AND SHIFTED EAST.

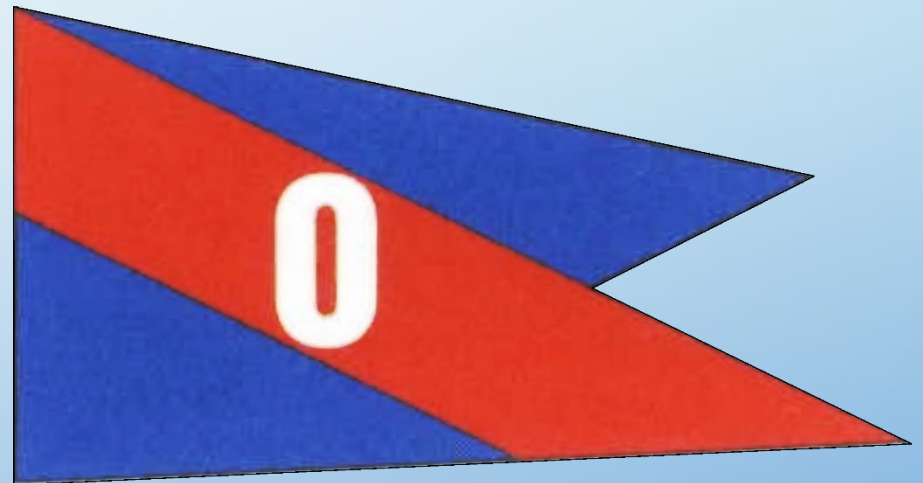

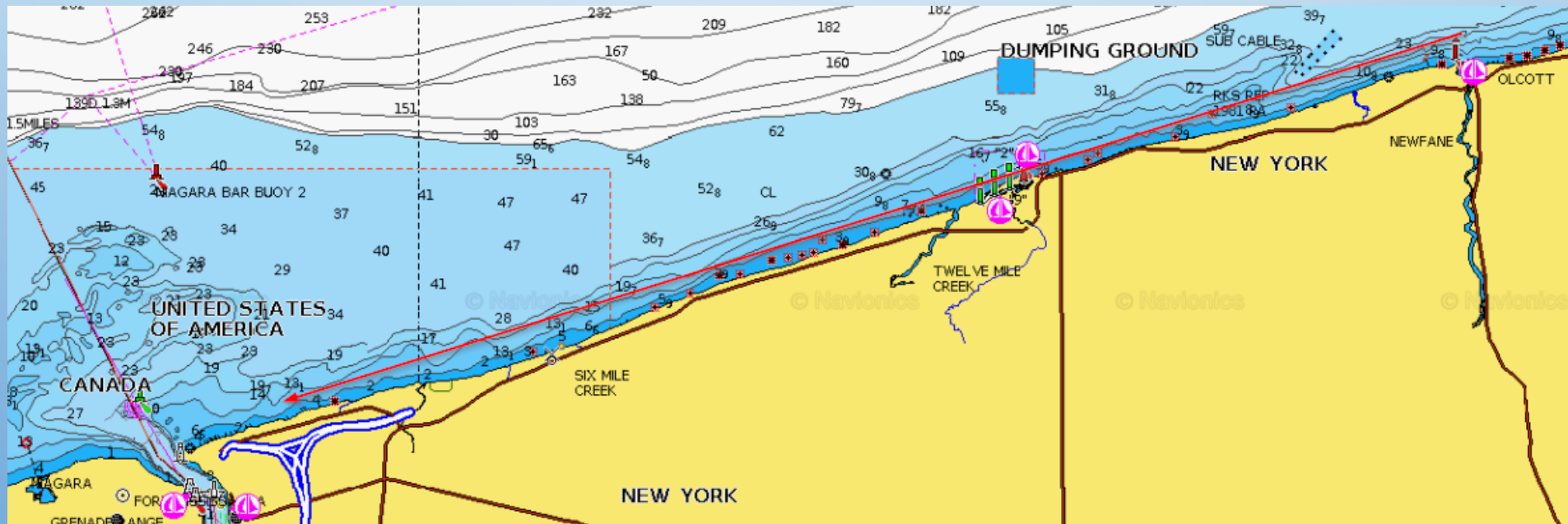
